The Shuni Field and Forest Center provides fun, hands-on outdoor education, and overnight accommodation for 500 students and teachers at once. ## \ Your donation will fund

The Shuni Field and Forest Center hopes to establish a cooking corner in the forest, and a composter that transforms organic waste into cooking gas. The system will allow students to toss organic waste from their meals and within 12 hours see it turn into cooking gas, teaches all visitors about the ecological value of reusable energy and avoiding pollution.

The cooking corner will contain the composting system, two built-in tabun ovens, a saj (breadmaking) corner, and five barbeque grills. Practically, this cooking corner has the additional advantage of decreasing the burden on the field kitchen at times when the center is fully occupied.
