Inspired by the unique atmosphere of the Elah Valley, professional dancers rehearse and perform, and offer professional training for dancers from around the world. They host 50,000 visitors a year.

Power of Balance Center is a unique mix-ability program for people with and without disabilities. Using movement as communication. Power of Balance empowers people with disabilities by creating a new language - dance- for expression and connection. Power of Balance was awarded the Ruderman Award for Disabilities in 2012 and the Genesis Prize Foundation-Itzhak Perlman in 2017.
